END NOTES

RE: Mr. Young

"Before the year 1729 is dismissed, attention must be called to a scandal which agitated the parish in the matter of the grave of a certain Thomas Young, of St. Dunstan's, who was buried in Holy Cross Churchyard Decr. 21, 1729. The first intimation of the trouble is given in the following.

"Memorandum -

Jan. 20; 1730 Agreed at a vestry That Thos: Strouts ye Churchwarden imploy a person to have Mr. Youngs Brick grave & tombe reduc'd to A common grave again.

"Witness our hands."

Then follow the signatures of nine parishioners.

In the following March another memorandum appears on the books "Agreed at a vestry March 31: 1731 That Thos: Strouts ye Church Warden imploy proper persons to prosecute ye people that got into ye Churchyard to put up Mr. Youngs tombe Stone.

"Witness our hands."

This again has nine signatures appended to it, but it did not bring peace; for "June 9: 1731 Thos: Strout ye Churchwarden is desired by A vestry then holden to present & procecut Susanna young for scolding & Brawling & distrubing ye parishions & A bussing Richd: Goulding AT a vestry ye 31 march 1731. Witness our hands" 7c. Yet again I read, "February 15th, 1731 we whose hands are hereunto subscrib'd do unanimously agree to Mr. Tho Strouts Artitling agains Susannah young." In the following November Mr. Cuckow received half a crown "for a Coppy of Mrs. Youngs ansewer," and "ye proctare" received a like sum, but how the dispute ended we do not know.
